## 2011/2012 SEASON EARLY REGISTRATION & PRESEASON CONDITIONING SKATE DATES

Pre-Season Conditioning Skate Registration and 2011/2012 Season Early Registration will be held at the John Lindell Arena, Royal Oak, for all players as follows:

### IMPORTANT REGISTRATION CHANGE:

For the 2011/12 season, USA Hockey and Michigan Amateur Hockey (MAHA) require that all players and coaches register on line prior to registering with ROHA. The cost is \$30.00 for USA Hockey plus \$5.00 for MAHA per player and can be done by credit card after 4/1/11, (age 6 and under are free).

### REGISTRATION MATERIALS:

To be assured selection onto a House Team or entry to the Beginner's Clinic, register by noon on September 10, 2011 and bring:

1. Enclosed ROHA REGISTRATION CARD - (Fill in the required info & correct any errors)
2. USA HOCKEY Confirmation of Registration Form\* (**See attached sheet for instructions**)
3. Appropriate ROHA registration fees (Payable to ROHA)

## **HOUSE TEAM PLAYERS:**

The registration fee for players includes: evaluation skates, insurance premiums, hockey socks and jersey for each skater and voting privileges at ROHA General Membership meetings for two adult members per family, generally mother and father. The registration fee is payable at the time of registration and is not refundable.

**Registration Fee: \$200/Player (\$175.00 for each additional player in family.) Note: Early registration discount: Register for the fall season by 8/15/11 and receive \$25.00 discount per player. Late Registration fee: after 9/10/11 registration fee is \$225.00**

During the season, a monthly ice fee will be paid in advance to the team manager. Team managers are responsible to pay the Association a monthly ice fee of **\$10.00** per player for each scheduled half-ice practice or game. Players on teams scheduled for 'ADM' type practices will pay **\$5.00** per skate.

***Mini-Mite ADM 1 Program: Players age 5 or 6 will play in an American Development Model style program with station based skill development type practices and cross-ice games. Players will skate an average of 10 times per month. Cost is \$480.00 for entire season, (\$450.00 if paid in full by 9/12/10), payable in 3 installments of \$160.00, due by 10/01/11, 11/15/11 and 1/1/12..***

***Mite: ADM 2 Program: All 7 year old players and those 8 year old players who choose to will play in an American Development Model style program with station based skill development type practices and ½ ice games. Players will skate an average of 10 times per month. Cost is \$525.00 for entire season, (\$500.00 if paid in full by 9/12/10), payable in 3 installments of \$175.00, due by 10/01/11, 11/15/11 and 1/1/12.***

***Mite Full Ice: Those players born in 2003 who have previously played full ice hockey have the option of playing on Mite Teams that will play full ice games for the 2011/2012 season. Registration fees and monthly ice payments are the same as those for House Team Players (above).***

**DELINQUENT PAYMENTS:** Any player falling in arrears **will** be suspended from participation until past due fees have been paid for all sessions.

**FUND RAISING POLICY:** ROHA will not have a mandatory fundraiser this year.

## **BEGINNER'S CLINIC ( for youngsters not on teams ):**

The ROHA Clinic is available to new skaters (4 years old +), who wish to learn basic skating and hockey skills. It is conducted each Saturday afternoon and Wednesday evening. Clinic fees are \$275.00 for the full season or \$150.00 for half seasons, registration fees are not refundable. For equipment and schedule information call Brian Brennan @ 248-752-2412

## **EQUIPMENT:**

Players on all ROHA House and Travel teams are required to have and use the following equipment: Unaltered H.E.C.C. approved helmet (with chin strap and properly attached H.E.C.C. face guard); Neck Guard (BNQ xxx) Certified; H.E.C.C. approved hockey skates; hockey shoulder pads, elbow pads, shin pads, practice jersey & socks, hockey gloves, hockey pants & athletic supporter with protective cup. A COLORED & unaltered internal mouth guard with its external strap attached to the face guard is required for all players at the Squirt age and older. (Mouth guards are recommended in younger age groups.) ROHA provides each team with game jerseys and each player with socks. Goalie pads & gloves will be provided to house teams. All coaches on the ice (Teams & Clinic) are required to wear an H.E.C.C. Certified Adult Hockey Helmet.

## AGE DIVISIONS:

Birth date determines the division in which players will skate. ROHA does not allow 'House' level players to play outside of their age group during the regular season.
