THESE TWO TEAMS COMBINED FOR A 7-9 REGULAR SEASON, YET HAVE KNOCKED OFF D1’S JUGGERNAUTS – A COMBINED 14 CHAMPIONSHIPS AMONGST THEIR PLAYOFF VICTIMS – TO EARN THEIR SPOTS IN THIS SEASON’S FINAL. WALLACE EXPRESS LOOKS TO CLAIM THEIR 3<sup>RD</sup> TITLE AND FIRST IN SIX SEASONS.
